A simple pegboard hook for 1/4in sockets.

This model is mde for a single socket. Now you don't have to print an entire organizer made for a whole set when you don't have the whole set.

Printing only the hooks you need to hang only the sockets you have saves space.

Indivual hooks allow for more flexibility in organizing your pegboard, whereas a singular socket organizer can only go in one spot.

Since the hook is minimalistic it uses comparatively less filament per socket than other models out there. Even if you print enough of these hooks to hang a whole set, you're using less filament than printing an organizer designed to hold a whole set.

The male-end of the hook is keyed to fit in the corners of the socket's receptacle. This ensures that every socket on every hook maintains the same orientation, giving an organized appearance.
