Summary

A simple bead used to keep a pace count when orienteering/hiking.

A simple bead used on a pace cord. Typical setup is 14 beads, 9 for 100m marks and 4 for 1000m marks. Proper tension is held on the bead when used with two lengths of 550 (4mm) paracord passed through the center with the center strands of the cord removed. For best spacing results start with a 500mm+ length of cord.

- Layer height 0.15mm.
- Infill 20%
- Perimeters: 3
- No supports needed.
