Magnetic Flag for US Mailboxes

A quick and easy to print replacement flag for mailboxes. Uses magnets to stick to the front of a metal mailbox (could be adhered with double-sided tape as well). Uses a few 6x3mm magnets to keep the flag in place whether it is out or put away.

Print Settings:

- Print files are pre-oriented for easy printing **without supports**.
- PETG is strongly recommended because this will more than likely be outside and exposed to the elements.





BOM:

- M2x4mm heat set inserts **(x6)**

- M2x4mm Screws **(x6)**
- 6x3mm Magnets **(x4)**
- 15x2mm Magnets **(x3)**
