Do you have a power strip with too many wall warts? This little device can help!

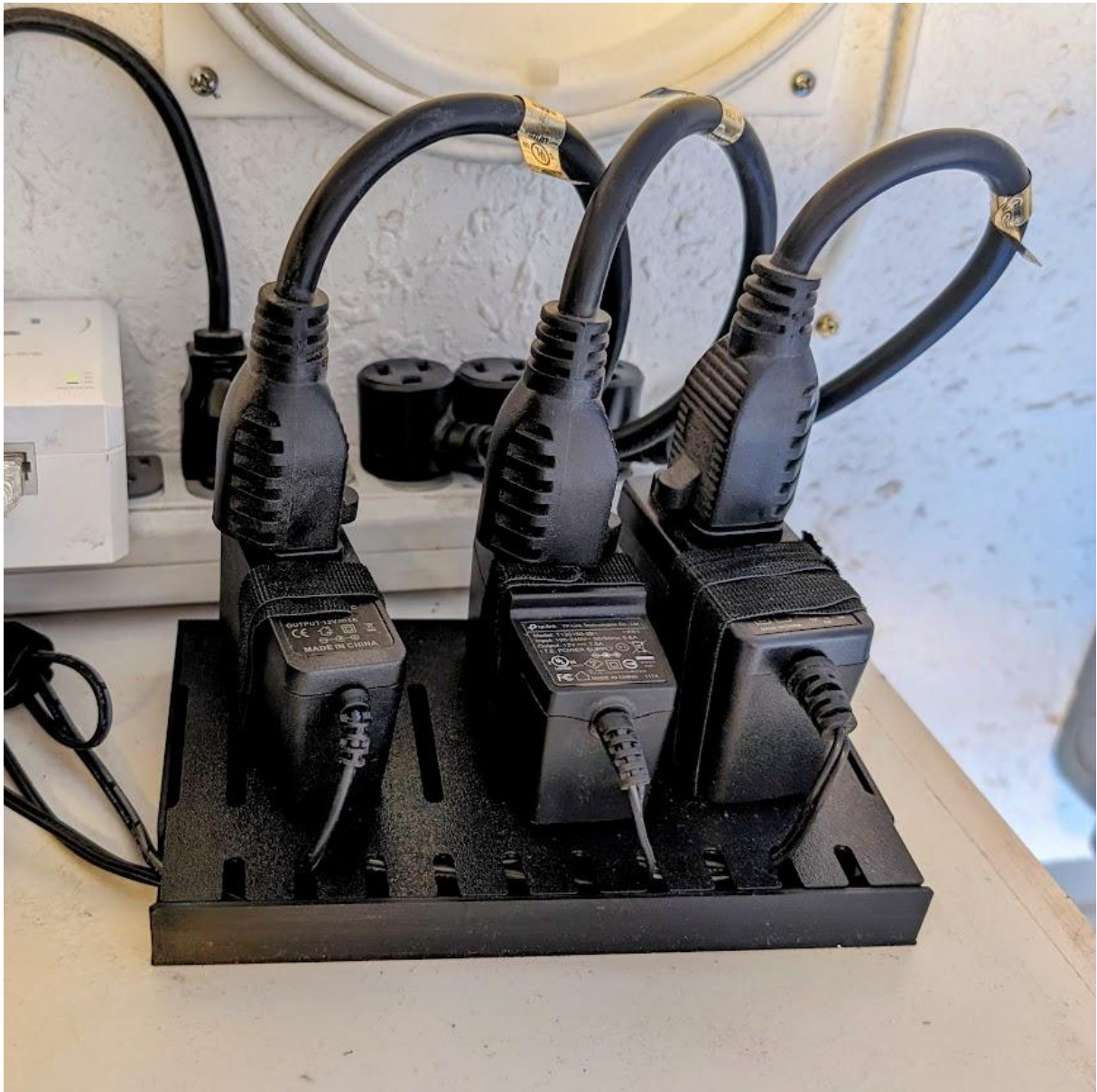

If you've ever had a power strip with too many wall warts, you know what a pain it can be. The wall warts block other outlets, they face the wrong direction, and just create general clutter.

This little device gives you one way to organize them and keep things looking a little neater. Buy a few 1-foot extension cords, plug the wall warts into those, and attach the wall warts to this organizer using velcro or zip ties. The excess wire can be wrapped around the internal posts inside of this organizer to keep things even tidier.

A photo is worth a thousand words.

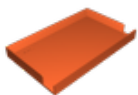


Note: wall warts can sometimes get very warm, so consider printing this in a heat resistant plastic. The **Prusa V0 PETG filament** would be perfect!

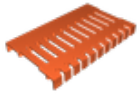
Fusion 360 file included in case you would like to make any changes.
