Summary

A thin shell that allows for feeling buttons easier with a GBA SP Emulator on the Galaxy Z Flip 5

This is a shell that can go on the lower half of a Galaxy Z Flip 5 phone. It has button cutouts so that you can use a GBA SP emulator (I use PizzaBoy), and be able to feel where the buttons are. This improves the feel of the emulator to feel closer to an actual GameBoy, and allows you to press buttons more accurately without looking, though it's not nearly the same as actual physical buttons

I used u/rayjt's GBA SP Wallpapers (https://www.reddit.com/r/galaxyzflip/comments/q16iue/galaxy_z_flip_3_gba_sp_wallpapers/) to get the placement of the buttons, and the buttons on the PizzaBoy Emulator to determine the size, so it should work if you use one of those emulators as a skin for the Emulator

This file may not fit exactly, I had to print it at 102% size to get it to fit neatly, but you may need to do some tweaking for your specific case to get it to fit just right.
