Emissary-class Cruiser were among the largest ships employed by the Republic Defense Coalition during the High Republic Era.

The Third Horizon was the flagship of Admiral Pevel Kronara. It participated in the Battle of the Kur Nebula and the Attack on the Lightning Crash.

This model is at 1:10,000 scale. It is 114mm long, 67mm wide, and 35mm tall.

It is based on its appearance in Star Wars The High Republic: Shadows of Starlight #3.

The model comes with a stand.

Print Instructions

Printed at 0.15mm layer height. Requires supports on buildplate.

For the stand, I've added filament changes at 1.25mm and 1.55mm.
