



Ikea Tertial Lamp Wall Mount Adapter

Summary

This is a little adapter to allow you to wall mount your Ikea Tertial lamp using studs.

The mount that is included with the Ikea Tertial lamp has 4 holes for mounting to a surface, but these make it nearly impossible to use a wall stud to mount the lamp. This adapter has two vertical holes for mounting to a stud and heated inserts or nut captures for bolting the lamp to the adapter. Heated inserts are recommended, but you can use the M5 Nut variant if you don't have any.

You'll need:

- #8 flathead wood screw.
 - Length isn't too important, as long as it's long enough to go through the mount and drywall into the stud. I used 1 1/4" because that's what I had on hand.
- M5 heated inserts OR M5 nuts
- M5x12mm machine thread screw.
 - If you're using heated inserts, these should be perfect. If you're using the captive nut, you might need to glue the nut to the

mount so that the bolt can reach it to start the thread. You could also try a 13mm long screw.
