A nice way to recycle your empty spools.

A dice tower made from empty filament spools. Just remove the plastic parts and stack the cardboard tubes.

You need:

- 1x Base that gets connected to a plastic shield of the spool.
- 1x Tray
- 6x Fences or 1x Fencing
- infinite amount of Rings

You can combine any sort of rings with each other, Boards work great with more Boards in opposing direction, and Bars work great with Holes alternating each step.

Finally you add one plastic shield as the top and thus get a wide filament spool or dice Tower.

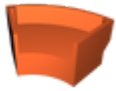
