I made this to cover table or counter top computer cord holes when they are loose or popped out. I modified someone's model from thingiverse I think but I don't remember which one it was. I added a solid bit in the center and decided it should be mostly solid to be strong and keep students from denting it or popping it out. I printed it mostly solid in black PLA or PETG. PLA plus should work as well, it depends on how hot your building gets in the summer with the a/c off. I superglued them in carefully after test fitting a couple of different sizes printed in lower infill rates to save plastic until I got a good fit. I think they look like they are original! The print with red is just for show. I ran out of black filament and switched to red for a prototype.

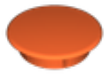
