



## Number Plate on GoPro Mount

### Summary

Mount a number plate (or other flat sign) to a GoPro mount.

This adapter let's you mount an number plate to the GoPro mount on your bicycle. It's is designed for the GoPro mount point found under many bike computer mounts. This allows your number plate to be fixed so that it does not interfere with your brake/shift cables, and doesn't rub on your frame.

The plate is 100mm wide x 70mm tall x 1mm thick. You can change the dimensions in your slicer by adding or subtracting a simple rectangle sized for your number plate.

In the picture, I used household glue to attach my event's front number to the plate. This had to dry overnight, but held up great in the rain on my event day (VeloCity Berlin 2024).

The corner-holes are designed for zip-ties. They provide an alternative way to mount your number without glue.

Recommended layer height: 0.30mm, and DRAFT mode. This produces a strong part with a standard 0.4mm nozzle.
