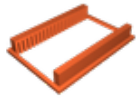
My Wife does Cross Stitch. While looking for a print to help hold and organize her floss for projects she found the holder created by Pugwhan_35875, <https://www.printables.com/en/model/889354-cross-stitch-holder> .

I have printed a fair few of them and so my wife went looking for a way organize and store them. She did not find anything so she tasked me with creating one. I am not the best creator, this is my first successful creation, but I gave it a go and now I am giving back.

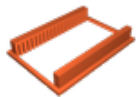
We used a filebox from OfficeDepot, <https://www.officedepot.com/a/products/570600/Office-Depot-Brand-Mobile-File-Box/>, as the primary storage container, and I built my measurements from all the items. The print itself can hold 19 Holders.

I used Ploymaker Gold PLA on an Ankermake M5 with a .4 nozzle on a .25 layer height (fast setting) with supports on the AnkerMake Studio (based off of PrusaSlicer). I had to split it in two to fit on my bed. The attached picture shows it in the box unglued.
